

Global Situation




- 1.3 billion people in risk area
- 30 fold rise since 1960
- 4 fold rising in epidemic countries since 1970, more than 100 countries now.

History of Dengue in Thailand

- First sporadic case in 1949
- First outbreak occurred in 1958 in Bangkok with 2,706 cases (Morbidity 10.6 per 100,000 population) and 296 death (CFR 10.9%).
- The main vector is Aedes aegypti
- DEN1,DEN2,DEN3,DEN4 serotypes are found.
