# Carbapenem Resistance : What Should Clinicians Do?

- The first step is to ensure that whenever we write orders for antibiotics in hospitals and other inpatient facilities that we make sure the orders come with a dose, a duration, and an indication.
- The second thing that we can all make sure we are doing is getting the right cultures before we start therapy.
- The last thing that we really encourage people to do is apply the concept of a time-out in healthcare, after about 24 to 48 hours of therapy, reassess your therapy. Often, information has come to light in the first day or 2 of hospitalization that really can inform optimal use of antibiotics. to look at the information and, decide whether an antibiotic is even necessary in the first place -- does this patient really have an infection?
