# CASE 1

## **CASE 1**

- A 14- day-old girl presents with fever for 2 days
- Alert, no cough, no runny nose and no vomiting or diarrhea
- Term NB, NL, Apgar 9,10, no complication with exclusive breast feeding
- Maternal serologic test: negative
- No Hx of vaginal vesicular lesion

# CASE 1

- PE: T **38.3°C**, P 150/min, R 45/min  
BP 64/40 mmHg.
- Active, AF: 2x2 cm, no bulging, PF: 1FT
- Abdomen: soft, no hepatosplenomegaly
- No stiffness of neck, brudzinski sign: neg
- Eyegrounds: can't be evaluated
- CBC: **WBC 18,500 (N 70% L 26% M 4%)**  
Hct 48%, Plt 415,000 UA: no RBC/WBC
