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- Thai girl
- •Age: 8 year-old
- Date of admission: 1st Nov 2012

- ➤ Known case of ALL, first diagnosed on 7.2.54, with complete remission on 21.3.54.
- First bone marrow relapse on 27.2.55. On monthly chemotherapy with the last one, a month before admission
- > Chief complaints of:
  - Fever for 9 days

## PRESENT ILLNESS (1)

• 9 days PTA, she developed fever, without chills or rigors, non-productive coughing without runny nose

• No sore throat, fast or difficult breathing, rash, bleeding from any site, abnormal movement or alteration in consciousness or activity and no history of poor oral intake

## PRESENT ILLNESS (2)

• She took only acetaminophen for the fever

• 3 day PTA, she developed loose stools one episode; the stool was watery without blood or mucus

• The mother took her to a local hospital the next day
